NOTICE OF VACANCY

PARISH COUNCILLOR for Kingstone Parish

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a casual vacancy is deemed to have occurred in the office of Councillor for the **Kingstone Parish** following the **death** of **Nicholas Paus Knudsen**.

Rules 5(5) and 5(6) of the Local Elections (Parish and Communities) (England and Wales) Rules 2006, provides that on a casual vacancy occurring in the office of **Parish** councillor within six months before the day on which that councillor would regularly have retired, the **Kingstone & Thruxton Group Parish Council** may, as soon as practicable after the expiry of the period of fourteen days* after the date of this notice (i.e. no later than **Wednesday, 18th January 2023**) has been given in accordance with section 89(3) of the Local Government Act 1972, co-opt a person to fill the vacancy.

Any vacancy not so filled must be filled at the next ordinary election.
